Hello Carrollwood, Happy 2014! A couple updates on grounds issues:

We have recent reports from OC residents that the lighting in our islands needs attention again: Thanks to OC residents Marc Cohen for donating bulbs and Anthony Cappadoro for donating time to replace the bulbs. Mr. Cappadoro and I toured the grounds during the December Grounds Committee meeting and made notes on repairs that are necessary, some islands need new bulbs and some need new fixtures. We will replace the bulbs as needed and hire an electrician to make significant repairs. Remember, our lights are 110-volt fixtures, please do not attempt to make repairs on your own.

Thanks to OC resident Patrick Knowles for pointing out that our entrance lightning at Dale Mabry is out. The entrance lighting should be fixed by the time this issue of *The Caroler* is released.

We plan to replace mulch in our islands early in 2014, and repair the sidewalk behind Bank of America that leads from Butia Place to the Publix Shopping Plaza. The sidewalk repair is a significant expense, and this improvement is pending approval of the debt refinancing that CRD President Mickey Jaap described in the October *Caroler* (previous *Caroler* issues can be downloaded at www.originalcarrollwood.com). Assuming the refinancing goes through as planned, we will potentially have additional budget to repair this sidewalk and affect other improvements in our neighborhood.

We closed out the first year of our term on a high note, Treasurer Cary Brown reported that the refinance of our debt is back on track, now with the Bank of Tampa. Our current bank (SunTrust) was unable to complete the transaction, so we are going with the second place bidder, and if all goes well, we will close on a new loan in January and benefit from a substantial cut in the rate of interest we are paying. Watch for updates on this issue in future issues of *The Caroler* or contact Cary directly if you have any questions.

As required by law, we scheduled our 2014 organizational meeting. It will be held on Monday, January 13th at 6 p.m. at the Carrollwood Recreation Center. At this meeting we will elect officers, appoint committee chairmen, and schedule our regular monthly meetings for 2014. We have received some requests to hold our regular meetings on the first Monday of each month to coincide with meetings of the Carrollwood Civic Association, but as many residents have come out against this change as have supported it. If there is no overwhelming support for a change, we will continue to have our meetings on the second Monday of each month.

At the December meeting, we held a lengthy discussion of the future of Original Carrollwood Park. Many ideas were presented, but the most notable were:

Construct a parking lot at the current dog park entrance, allowing users easier access to the park.

Move the dog park to the east side of OCP, and/or move the entrance to the southeast corner of the park.


Sell the west third of the park to commercial interests, and include in the sale construction of a large enough wall on the west border to seal off trespassers access to Dale Mabry, then use those funds to add significant improvements to all the neighborhood parks.

We will continue to discuss options to improve this park in future meetings, and may schedule one or more special meetings to deal exclusively with this park. Keep an eye on future *Caroler* articles if you have any interest in the future of OCP.


In my November article, we publicized our plans to possibly remove the basketball hoops at OCP. Prior to our recent meeting, the hoops were stolen, and no CRD residents expressed any concerns about this issue. So absent any resident demand, we will not replace the stolen hoops.

We discussed the issue of removal of the Moscovy ducks from Cooper Park. Although some concerns were raised, there were no objections to removal of this invasive species. Absent any resident opposition to removal, it will occur sometime in January.

We were informed by resident Dr. Rick Meyer that SWFMD plans to begin pumping 2 million gallons of water daily from Blue Sink, a sinkhole in the vicinity of Florida and Fowler Avenues. There was a public meeting in Forest Hills about this issue in November, but our neighborhood received no notice. Unfortunately the deadline for filing complaints about this plan was December 18th, and by the time you read this, that deadline will have passed. At this (continued on Page 6)



This & That

OC REAL ESTATE SELLING YOUR HOME 101

AS-IS WITH RIGHT TO INSPECT

These contracts have definite pros and cons. Most of our homes in OC are 50's through 70's vintage always requiring a little work here and a little work there. Buyer's inspectors are usually very diligent in their efforts to find blemishes. Under standard Florida Real Estate, contract Sellers are not required to repair/replace any item that is not warranted under the contract. Such things as pitted marcite in pools, nail holes in walls or normal cosmetic conditions in the home might be reflected in the inspectors report but they are not all warranted and should not be a financial burden to you.

Now, for the double-edge sword; the risk you normally take by using the standard contract is up to 1.5% of selling price each for repairs, wood-destroying organisms, and permitting. If the inspector comes up with a problem or problems that require more than the 1.5% cost, you may have to have it fixed anyway if you want to keep that buyer. If you loose that buyer, you will still have to disclose the problem in your sellers disclosure because you are now aware of it. Of course that risk goes away with the AS-IS contract. However, the AS-IS Florida Real Estate contract allows the potential buyer to walk away from the contract at anytime during the inspection period without the need to justify their reason.

Recommendation: Sit down with your Realtor and discuss your options before you decide which way to go.




