Three Simple Financial Tips

Happy New Year! Turning the calendar over offers an opportunity to embrace new things or make a few changes.

Here are three simple ideas that can help your financial life in 2017:

1. Adopt simple budgeting

It's easy to get lost in a complex budgeting system. Instead of classifying money with confusing accounts and sub-accounts, consider a streamlined budget of three categories:

- Reoccurring expenses
- Lifestyle expenses
- Savings

Money can only be classified in one of those categories. Most people don't need to waste time trying to decide if a date night should be "dining out" or "entertainment" or "food" or anything else -- it doesn't really matter. If it's not a bill related to your basic standard of living (utilities, cell phone, insurance), it's a lifestyle expense.

If you don't spend it in one of these categories, transfer those funds out of your checking account at the end of each month to savings.

2. Set up visual triggers for goals

Did you know that visual triggers can lead to reaching your goals? When your brain sees things, the picture reminds us of specific goals or serves as extra motivation. Here are two examples of what this could look like:

• If you shop online, make a picture of a vacation you want to take your background image on your device or computer. When you go to use it, look at the picture and ask if this transaction will help you get to your goal.

• If you want to get out of debt, make a chain out of paper rings. Each ring represents \$100. Every time you pay down the balance, rip off part of the chain. The visual imagery sparks the motivation to do what it takes to accomplish your goals.

3. Have a plan for bonus dollars/windfalls

Bonuses, tax refunds, and other windfalls can be pleasant surprises. Unless you have a plan for them in advance, you'll likely spend these dollars. Come up with a strategy to use the majority (like 75 - 90%) of your windfall to pay down debt or to make large deposits towards savings goals. Spend the difference on something that can create a positive experience for you or your family.


