



We are thrilled to have won the Yard-of-the-Month award this month! We have put a lot of thought and care into the design and upkeep of our yard, so this is a great honor. As neighborhoods go, Original Carrollwood is one of the most beautiful in Tampa, but what first drew us here was the midcentury modern architecture of our house. The architecture is reminiscent of Southern California mid-century modern post and beam homes, so we thought it would be cool to pay homage to those iconic homes by including many exotic, drought-tolerant plants found abundantly in the yards of many Palm Springs homes.

Our granite gravel beds are dotted with bromeliads, agave, various succulents, and the lush stems of the foxtail fern. The centerpiece of each bed include a a large spineless yuca and Buddha belly bamboo plant. These beds require minimal upkeep, except for some occasional weeding and trimming.

We are both originally from the northern states, so our more traditional green patch of lawn in the front makes us nostalgic for home. It is comprised of Zoysia grass bordered by Weeping Podocarpus and a thicket of jasmine. We also love our two large mature oaks in the out-lawn, which create


