

The CRD Board is moving forward with recommending a tax increase to the Community. A vote by the Community is required, and it must be done during a regularly scheduled election - which will be the August 23rd primary. There will be a public hearing at the April CRD meeting, a postcard will be mailed out in March, along with a newspaper legal notice.

We are soliciting community feedback now.

What would you like to see if the tax increase successfully passes? Here are just a few items in the hopper:

- △ New playground equipment at Original Carrollwood Park and Scotty Cooper Park
- △ New fencing at Original Carrollwood Park
- △ Access control at the front entrance to White Sands Beach
- △ Pickleball court at Original Carrollwood Park
- △ More tree trimming throughout the Community
- △ Small playground area at White Sands Beach
- △ Hitting wall at the tennis courts
- △ Improving center area and pavers between the tennis courts
- △ Fitness equipment around Original Carrollwood Park



REAL ESTATE 101: THE NEIGHBORHOOD

Tampa's growth is attributed to the supply, demographic behavior and economic fundamentals. Our market's fast-moving inventory supplied with plentiful buyers and fewer homes built by builders, has led to fewer days on market. It's tough for buyers with our current market condition. New listings are snatched up quickly when priced competitively and in move-in condition leaving buyers behind who are moving slow to readily make competitive offers in multi-offer scenarios. Both baby boomers and millennials represent the bulk of the market. Our new "work from home" environment allows new buyers to work anywhere for the same amount as the Northern states. while eliminating higher taxes. With our state's leanest mandates on CDC guidelines and quality of life, homebuyers are migrating to our state for quality of life. Baby boomers are still hot to purchase homes to be closer to family grandchildren, etc. Millennials are hitting the age to settle in to their ideal community and

home that suits the family's needs and lifestyle. As you saw from the pandemic, lesser skilled workers and materials to avail, Tampa has added .63 jobs per housing unit, despite our loss of one per each new housing unit built.

With climbing interest rates in 2022,

this will restrict inventory in expensive markets making home loans higher to afford for eager buyers. This especially affects the first-time homebuyer market or those looking in lesser expensive markets. Historically speaking, the lesser desirable and lower priced community markets tend to depreciate in value at a higher rate versus communities, such as our Carrollwood community to remain strong during any recession. Pasco and Hernando counties have increased in value this past year with new home growth and those looking to cash out on their equity and downsize. Sellers will remain in the driver's seat for the coming year, while homebuyers will most likely have to wait another year for any reprieve.




