

COYOTES IN ORIGINAL CARROLLWOOD

There are have been recent sightings of coyotes in Original Carrollwood.

From Fish & Wildlife Commission:

What you should do if you see a coyote.

Coyotes are not large animals and rarely pose a threat to people, especially adults. They can be curious but are also timid and generally run away if challenged. If a coyote approaches too closely, there are methods you can use to deter it and frighten it away. Hazing the animal by making loud noises and acting aggressively will typically cause a coyote to leave an area, but you may need to increase and continue hazing efforts until the coyote is effectively deterred and leaves the area for good. There are several methods of hazing that are effective with coyotes.

Prevent Problems with Coyotes

Never feed coyotes either intentionally or unintentionally. This includes placing food outside to attract wildlife. Clean up pet food, fallen fruit and seed around bird feeders – coyotes are opportunistic feeders and will be drawn to and eat all of these potential food sources. Secure garbage cans and secure compost. Close off crawl spaces under porches and sheds to prevent

coyotes and other animals from resting or raising their young in areas around your home. Educate your neighbors and ask them to follow these same steps.

Coyotes can and do prey on domestic cats and small dogs. Most coyote attacks on pets occur either at night or in the early evening or morning hours (dusk and dawn). To protect your pets, do not allow them to roam freely. Keep cats indoors. Free-roaming cats are at a high risk of being preyed on by coyotes and other animals. Walk small dogs on a short leash that is less than six feet, especially at night, dusk or dawn. Be extra careful if you are going to walk your pet in wooded areas or areas that have heavy foliage, where coyotes may rest.

for all of the properties with the Sheriff's Office, and this gives a deputy automatic permission to trespass anyone, including a resident. It is unfortunate that this has to be done sometimes, but it is effective and works. So do not hesitate to make the call yourself.

Lastly, just a reminder that new boat decals and keys are now available. Please download the "boat decal contract" from the website, and fill it out prior to visiting the office. Janet can also email it to you. Also,

bring a copy of your current boat registration and trailer registration (all addresses must match your driver's license and titled in the resident's name). The cost is \$45.00, payable in cash, check, debit, or credit card.





Peanut Butter Green Beans





Boating Safety, Driving Tips and Etiquette

As spring approaches and more boaters enjoying Lake Carroll, we would like to remind everyone of some basic boating safety rules.

Lake Carroll: Boating & Personal Watercrafts (PWC, Jet Ski, Sea-Doo)

White Sand Beach area and the canals are considered a "NO WAKE ZONE." For safety of other boats and swimmers, enter and exit at a slow, safe speed.

Always boat on Lake Carroll in a counterclockwise direction.

Check the boat traffic on the lake. If there are too many boats pulling skiers/tubes, then wait until a few skiers are done with their runs. The

fewer boats operating with skiers on the lake, the safer it will be. Mornings and evenings are typically times with fewer boats on the water.

The main rule we see broken is boaters & PWCs (jet skis) following other boats pulling skiers/tubes entirely too close. Never follow directly behind another watercraft. PLEASE GIVE SKIERS and TUBERS SPACE.

PULLING SKIERS (skiing, wakeboarding, surfing, tubing)

All skiers/ wakeboarders/surfers should wear a coast guard approved life jacket. Keep your skier a safe distance from all docks, boats, structures, paddleboarders, kayakers, etc. Avoid power turns: when a skier falls, make sure to come off the throttle and slowly turn/approach your skier.

IRRIGATION, STORM WATER, AND OUR LAKES

As we move into the Florida dry season, many of us will rely on irrigation to keep our lawns and landscaping healthy and green. It's important that we adhere to county guidelines (see inset) regarding watering days and times to help conserve water and avoid fines. The guidelines apply to irrigation regardless of water source.

When the rains do return, we need to keep in mind that the vast majority of Original Carrollwood drains directly into Lake Carroll or Lake Lipsey. Any debris in our driveways or in the gutter end up in the lakes. As one can imagine, this could result in massive amounts of

material deposited in our lakes over time.

Most of us don't spend any time considering storm water and where it goes. Why would we? Modern storm water systems have settling ponds and traps in place to mitigate sediment and debris from getting into our waterways. We've learned to rely on these systems. Original Carrollwood was built before many of these storm water best practices were commonplace. As a result, it's up to each of us to keep debris out of our lakes to preserve their health.

These restrictions apply to most water sources, including private wells, ponds, or lakes used as alternate irrigation supply.

Addresses ending in 0, 1, 2 or 3 Addresses ending in 4, 5 or 6 Addresses ending in 7, 8 or 9 Mondays and Thursdays Tuesdays and Fridays Wednesdays and Saturdays

Locations with no address (common areas) and locations with mixed addresses (such as office complexes) Wednesdays and Saturdays

All watering must be done either between midnight and 8 a.m. OR between 6 p.m. and midnight, and only once on your designated days.
