

A letter from The Carrollwood Recreation District Board

A Little More Will Go A Long Way Toward Preserving Tampa's Best Kept Secret.

The Original Carrollwood Community is one of Tampa's best kept secrets, with charm on every corner. If you call OC home, this comes as no surprise. We are fortunate to have some coveted amenities: Our Recreation Center has two event rooms and lighted tennis courts; White Sands Beach offers a boat ramp, a dock, a swimming area, and access to Lake Carroll; Scotty Cooper Park is fully equipped with a playground, a dock, and a covered pavilion for parties; and Original Carrollwood Park is large enough to have softball and soccer fields, a paved track for walking or biking, two covered pavilions, and a dog park that canines rave about. All of the facilities are private and for use by Original Carrollwood residents only. Beyond all that, OC is a slice of Americana, hosting annual fireworks on New Year's Eve, Easter Egg hunts, a ski show and free barbeque on July 4th, a Halloween Parade, and on occasion, movies at Original Carrollwood Park. It all adds up to an amazing neighborhood, the maintenance of which also adds up.

Keeping Original Carrollwood safe and beautiful is getting increasingly costly. Financial projections show that our future income will not keep up with the rate of inflation. It is for this reason that the Board is diligently seeking to increase the non-ad valorem annual assessment for each residence.

Consider this. Just as the cost of one gallon of milk has nearly doubled in the past 20 years, from an average cost in 2002 of \$3.49 to a whopping \$6.54 in 2022, so too has inflation raised the cost of everything the district uses to support and maintain the neighborhood. By our projections, the district budget will run at a deficit within the next five years.

Your Voice Will Be Heard, And Your Vote Counted.

It is important to note that the decision to raise taxes will not be made by the Board alone. This is a neighborhood decision. It will be decided by all of us—together. This is why we're asking for your input. On Monday, April 11th, at 6:30 p.m., the Carrollwood Recreation District will hold a public hearing at the Rec Center; the purpose of which is to consider placing a referendum on the August 23, 2022, public elections ballot proposing to change the annual assessment from \$600 to a cap of \$1,200 per year. If approved, the Board will raise the annual assessment as needed to meet budget projections. In the past, this was done incrementally over a course of years.

Approving this resolution on August 23 will help ensure the future financial stability of Original Carrollwood and will add the funds needed to enhance the neighborhood and the facilities that we already enjoy.

We look forward to hearing from you on April 11th and to discussing the future of the neighborhood we love.


