





So what do you do when your parents move out of their house into assisted living, or worse yet they



pass on. You know the routine the only sure things are death and taxes. Well, it can be overwhelming.

The original owner has occupied many of our Carrollwood homes since they were built. Since then, many have had no upgrades. That may seem unbelievable to you, but many of these people were quite happy with the way they set up their home and never had any desire to change it.

We've discussed in the past that the National Association of Realtors did a study on 25 different upgrades done on homes and found that the only upgrade that yielded more money in the sale than cost was related to the garage. I would suggest to you that flippers have the edge on the normal person, but even they don't always get it right often resulting in substantial losses.

Some heirs look upon the event as one where they want to yield "X" number of dollars and then base their pricing decision on that. This is not going to get the property sold. It will, however, get you a lot of frustration.

These homes are now 50 and 60 years old. They have copper plumbing, which over this period of time will often develop pinhole leaks. When that happens, the correct repair is to re-plumb. \$4,000 - \$6,000. Roofs are often 12 or more years old and have lost their usefulness. \$10,000 - \$20,000. Redoing the kitchen can be \$25,000 -\$40,000. Trust me on that one because I have been trying to redo the kitchen in my home for two years and prices have been astronomical. Bathrooms can cost anywhere from \$6,000 - \$10,000 for just modest upgrades. Pools often need resurfacing (\$4,000- \$6,000), and cool decks are dated leaving one to get pavers. \$6,000 - \$10,000. Windows are leaking in the corners causing deterioration of the drywall. \$8,000 -\$10,000 for windows and \$1,000 plus for drywall repairs. Then the heating and cooling systems. \$4,000 - \$6,000 per system.
