As spring heats up into summer, the CRD is working to keep up with needed repairs and maintenance to all of the facilities. Staying ahead of both vandals and normal wear and tear are on ongoing challenge.

In June, we will be issuing new boat stickers and keys for the ramp. Keys and permit stickers will only be issued for boats



and jetskis registered to a resident of the Carrollwood Recreation District. Boats not owned by a resident are not permitted to use the boat ramp at the beach, and we will not issue keys or stickers if the registrant cannot prove both residency and ownership. The cost per vessel registration is \$45.

The procedure this year will be a bit different. All boat owners must submit a \$45 check payable to the Carrollwood Recreation District along with required documentation to Lina at the Recreation Center Office on or before 1 p.m., Friday, June 13th. There will be no secondary deadline for this submission. Required documentation includes: Proof of residency within the District, such as a utility bill or government issued photo ID with address; current registration indicating that the boat is registered in the name of the District resident; and a completed Boat Decal Contract Form. You can access the form in advance on the Carrollwood website at http://www.originalcarrollwood.com/wp-content/ uploads/2014/05/Boat-Decal-contract-2014.pdf

When you turn in your documents and payment, Lina will schedule a visit to your home by a member of the CRD Board. The available dates and times for visits will be between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. on four nights:

Wednesday, June 18th

Thursday, June 19th

Tuesday, June 24th

Wednesday, June 25th

We will then deliver the sticker(s) and key to your home at the appointed time, and we will apply the stickers to your boat and trailer to complete your registration.

The locks will be changed before the July 4th weekend, so keep your old key until the locks are changed. Be sure to set yourself a reminder of the deadlines and documentation requirements.

At our May meeting, we discussed the current qualifying periods for the November elections. As of the date this article is published, the time for qualifying via petition will have passed. However, there is a second qualifying week in June. June qualifying is open from Noon on Monday, June 16th through Noon on Friday, June 20th. To qualify for the ballot, that week candidates must submit a \$25 (continued on Page 7)





Looking ahead to July, it will again be time for the July 4th parade and party at White Sands Beach. Watch for announcements from the Civic Association for details.







OC Resident Completes Boston Marathon

I am writing you as a proud husband of a very special woman. My wife, Michelle Thames, completed the Boston Marathon for the second year in a row. Due to the events last year, we never had the opportunity to truly celebrate her accomplishment. Although many did not finish last vear. Michelle crossed the finish line well ahead of the explosions. Even though she finished ahead of the bombs, her cell phone was dead and we were separated during the attack. Fortunately, we were reunited an hour later, uncertain of what could be next. My experience of being 800 feet from the explosions and the reality of us being so close to such a horrific event changed us instantly. That said, thousands of people were impacted in a way that I can never imagine. The evening after the race was somber and we were glad when our plane landed in Tampa the next morning. Immediately following the tragedy, Michelle made the decision to return to participate in the 2014 marathon in spite of the terrorist. Our room was booked within weeks - an example that the American spirit cannot be broken.

We traveled back to Boston this year and had a tremendous time! Michelle rocked the marathon finishing 3:29:23, which is 4th place for all the women in the Tampa Bay Area.

As a longtime Original Carrollwood Resident, 1977-1984/2005-present, I am very proud of the neighborhood which we call home. Michelle has run thousands of miles through our neighborhood streets over the years. This includes the training for the Boston Marathon.

Michelle is a mother of three beautiful children, including a boy in kindergarden at Carrollwood Elementary. Also to note, Michelle is in the OC Running Group - *The Caroler* did a story on the group last year. Her good friend and Carrollwood resident, Jill Kralovanec, also finished the 2013 & 2014 Boston Marathon.




CRD Election Qualification by Fee & Submission of **Required Documentation** Noon, June 20, 2014
