

Alexandra Melendi

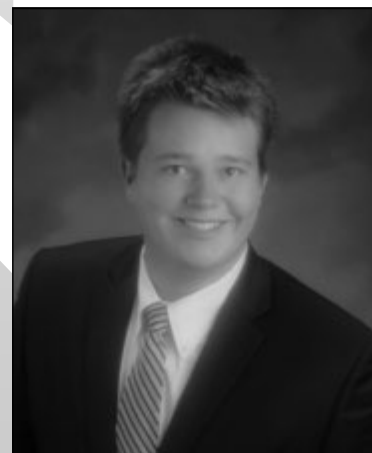

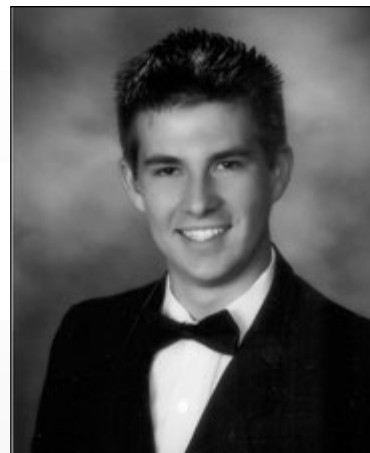

OC REAL ESTATE SELLING YOUR HOME 101 4-POINT INSPECTION- HEATING SYSTEM

In this second of four-part series on the "4-Point Inspection" required by most insurance companies, we will address the heating and A/C systems. The most significant part is the age. First, is the system in good working order? The inspector will operate both heating and cooling sides through the thermostat and check the temperature of the air as it passes through the ventilators to make sure it is working properly. For example, normal cooling will come out at a temperature of 8-10 degrees below the inside temperature and reverse for the heat.

They will check wood burning stoves for professional installation and chimneys to assure that there are no weaknesses, rust, or deterioration of the stack/flue or breakdown of the firewall.

They will also look for space heaters and if they are a primary source of heat that will be a significant drawback to acceptance. Obviously, our homes in Carrollwood are not of that vintage, but one never knows for sure what some people do behind closed doors.

For us, the primary problem becomes age. In one of my previous reports I addressed A/C's, but I just want to reiterate once more. If your system is over 15 years old it's probably on its last legs and it's costing you serious money in electric bills each month. In my case, I replaced

my 1985 vintage unit three years ago because I figured it was on its last leg even though it still worked. The impact I felt tracking usage over the first year was a savings of 42% the first year. For me, that meant a return-investment payback in five years.

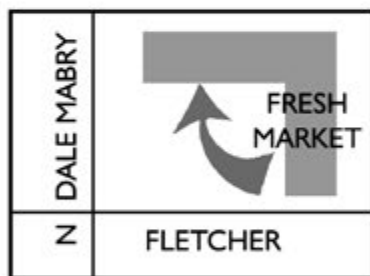
