

Summer is in full swing, vacations are on everyone's mind, and Lake Carroll is getting its usual workout with upward of 20 or more boats and jetskis underway at once on weekend afternoons. Now that the boat ramp lock has been updated and new keys and stickers issued, I want to remind all beachgoers not to bring any glass to White Sands Beach. If you have bottles in your boat or car, do not put them in the trashcans at the beach. Leave them stowed away and take them home with you. Glass left in the trashcans often ends up broken in the water courtesy of late night vandals. This occurred just a week or two before the July 4th weekend. Fortunately due to the clarity of the water, Property Manager, John Probst, was able to locate and remove all of the broken glass.

Just remember, bringing glass to the beach is a bad idea. Leaving it there is even worse.

We recently completed the annual mulch replacement in the neighborhood, which will make for a much nicer appearance, and a safer experience for the kids in the Cooper Park playground. The depth of the mulch is designed to provide a much softer landing when the little ones occasionally trip or fall.

Our annual audit for the year ending September 30, 2013, is now complete and posted on the website, as well as, the recently approved budget for the year starting October 1, 2014. We included a lot of capital

improvements that can only be funded if our refinance effort is a success, which is still ongoing.

The July 4th Parade and party was again an incredibly fun way to celebrate the holiday. When you see the CCA Board members around the neighborhood, make sure you take time to thank them for all of their efforts, especially Neil Norden who was out at the beach before 8 a.m. working hard to get everything set up. The activities sponsored by the CCA are a big part of what makes our neighborhood special.

The Recreation Center Office is undergoing another change in personnel. Lina Young has left as our Office Manager, and we are actively searching for her replacement. Interested applicants should contact Mark Snellgrove. See his article in this edition of *The Caroler* for more information.

Elections qualifying has passed, and there are eight candidates qualified for the November ballot. Since we have nine seats open, the names will not appear on the ballot, and all eight will be automatically elected. Florida law provides that the outgoing Board of Trustees will appoint someone to fill the one vacancy for the 2015-2016 term. This appointment will occur at the last meeting of the current Board in December of this year.

It seems like summer goes by faster every year. I can't





I found the July, 1961, Caroler the other day in a box of old papers that belonged to my father, George Carnes, who was the CCA Treasurer at the time.




