






Goin' to the Dogs!



On The Lake Wakesurfing Setup

This month we are focusing on setting up your boat for wakesurfing. Knowing your boat setup is one of the most important parts of enjoying the endless wave and going ropeless.

1. Boat and Equipment:

Inboard boats are recommended for wakesurfing. Outboard and I/O boats are not safe for wakesurfing. I always recommend getting a wakesurf specific rope. Wakesurf ropes are shorter in length, thicker and easy to hold onto. Using a ski rope can cause injury from the long thin material getting wrapped around a foot or hand. And with any waterskiing activity, a coast guard approved life jacket is recommended.

2. Ballast Setup:

For wakeboarding and surfing, the key to a larger wake is displacement of the hull. More weight in the boat causes more displacement and larger wakes. Many of the newer wakeboard boats come with ballast systems installed. Also, some new boats have surf systems installed. These surf systems will allow you to weight the boat differently (or produce a wave with minimal weight added). Make sure you are familiar with the system your boat comes with. I will focus on the basics for the majority of boats.



To increase the size of the wave and push, you will need to increase the weight in the boat. The general rule is to add weight to the side of the boat that you will be surfing on. Weight can be additional ballast bags and/or people. You will be "listing" the boat toward the side you are surfing on. If you put more weight in the back of the boat, the wave will be taller but shorter in length. Putting weight in the front of the boat will increase the length of the wave but make it shorter in height. Spend time experimenting to find the best setup for your boat.

One thing to note, Lake Carroll has several shallow areas. While wakesurfing, you will see the best wave when you are in 10' or more in water depth.
