

## WHAT HAVE WE LEARNED?

I first started writing articles in *The Caroler* when the COVID pandemic hit. Can you believe it's four years this December when the first confirmed cases began emerging in China? We were masking, vaccinating, distancing and disinfecting.

So, what have we learned (besides making sourdough, learning how to Zoom and subscribing to Netflix)?

Besides being a life coach, I work as Coordinator of Social Services for a 62 and older residence. I've been asking the folks who live there what the pandemic taught them. Among the more salient responses was this one:

"COVID 19 was such a divider. It was a wedge between political parties, ideologies and even among families. So what I learned was to listen and not judge; to hear without needing to express my opinion. I learned not to have to be right or be the loudest or be the smartest. COVID taught me that relationships are the most important thing and I value other people- even if they hold vastly different ideas about life."

While new listings decreased by 7% month-over-month, they are down 23% from last year. This is an indicator that people are becoming more stable. There is still an issue with people leaving certain metropolitan areas and coming to Florida in order to get away from some out-of-control conditions in some of our Northeast, mid-West, and Western States.

The number of units sold decreased by 14% and have declined year-over-year by 2%

Sales volume has also declined by 4% year-over-year and average days on the market has more than doubled since last year.

All of these indicators tend to create a model of stabilization in the industry. Obviously, with interest rates climbing through the ceiling, people are choosing not to get rid of their current low rates from the past couple years. And, while the FED continues to raise rates, manufacturers of building products have continued to increase their rates. Once new housing slows down, these products should begin to stabilize. However, it is not likely that housing costs will decline significantly along with everything else. 0




