

The CRD Board is pleased to announce that the referendum results have been certified by the Hillsborough County Canvassing Board, and as such, the assessment rate has been set at \$800 for each OC home. This is a 20year business plan. The budget is included below with the biggest expense of placing \$150,000 back into the reserve (savings) account. There were six communities in Hillsborough County with referendums on the August 23rd ballot, OC was the leader with the highest percentage of approval at 81.68

Betty Owen

BEFORE OC

A two-year domestic science course at a college in Manchester led Betty to work with schools cooking with many others in a large kitchen, about 2000 meals a day! After a short time, she found herself in her own kitchen cooking 125 meals a day, eventually leading to 350 per day with four assistants.

Betty & Terry married and they moved to Scotland. Being 23 years old, Terry had just received his PhD; however, due to post-war restrictions wasn't permitted to leave the country for three more years. He choose to work for the government and they found themselves living in the Scottish wilderness as Terry worked for an explosives factory. This age restriction also prevented Terry from accepting an invitation to do research at Harvard.

Betty Owen has lived on Samara Drive for 58 years.

The Owen family moved to Carrollwood from Yorkshire, England, in December 1963 when OC was the ONLY Carrollwood. Betty's husband, Terry, was employed at USF in those days. Sunstate Builders was offering special incentives to Professors to build in Carrollwood. The timing was perfect.

Terry had been on sabbatical at Vanderbilt in 1960. During that time while on a student trip to Panama City, the chairman of the USF Department of Chemistry invited him to stay at his home in Carrollwood. Terry knew then he wanted to move his family to this wonderful neighborhood and wanted to live on the lake and raise thier children here.

In 1963 when Terry was offered a position at USF, he asked Betty if she would like to move to the States. Betty said "Yes, so long as there is a dishwasher and pest control!"

The Owens family moved to Tampa one day after Christmas and rented a home near USF, offered through the math department at USF. They lived there until the construction of their home was complete.

Their home was to be the first around the inlet. It was February 1964 when they began digging the inlet. The surrounding area was nothing but dirt and trees. Betty said, "We watched the digging of the canal and the building of Duck Island, and then, finally, that big day when they removed the dam and we watched the water pour into the canal. Exciting times!"

Construction of the Owen's home began in

March, after the inlet was finished, and was completed in June. At that point, the road wasn't even in place, nor had electricity been installed. The developer spread shells to allow vehicles to travel in the area. Terry told TECO, "We're moving in the first week of August, so make it happen!" TECO made it happen. Unfortunately, every afternoon storms caused the electricty to go out. Betty said TECO eventually got tired of coming out for repairs and installed a heavy-duty line. The Owens moved into the house in August 1964, but there were still no roads.

The Owen children, Judy and John, grew up on the Lake Carroll and rode their bicycles to school, the ballfield, boy scouts, —everywhere! Living was easier back then and

doors didn't need to be locked!

Judy and John were rewarded a dollar each time they swam around the island. At one time, Betty and Terry told Judy if she could swim to the island and back they could get a boat. She made it! The children often went sking on the Lake. They put a quarter in the 'kitty jar' each week. That was enough to cover the gas for the boat at that time. Imagine!

The Owen home on Samara Drive was awarded 'Yard of the Month' in September 2018. Other than cutting the grass and trimming the big trees, Betty lovingly takes care of all landscaping and gardening details. Her children wrote, "Along the way, she has dealt with snakes, frogs, lizards, and the occasional otter, but no amount of wildlife or hot and humid Florida weather can keep her from making sure that she does her part to ensure that Original Carrollwood continues to retain its beauty and long-standing reputation as the 'Lovely Land of Woods and Water'." Betty continues to be involved in the Community and occastionally attends Board meetings. CRD President Mark Snellgrove said, "Betty has always been gracious and allowed contractors to trek through her backyard to access Duck Island for maintenance."

Betty tells me she loves the annual Christmas boat parade watching as the boats come around Duck Island. This past year they counted 39 boats. The annual 4th of July Ski Show is also a family favorite. (continued on Page 16)


September was a busy month for Carrollwood Owls!

REAL ESTATE 101: VRBO

It just so happens that I'm currently on vacation in Lake Toxaway, N.C., right next to Cashiers which is the 2nd home of many Tampans. Back in my teaching days, many of Hillsborough County teachers would buy a Jim Walters Home and then put it on a plot of land on the Cullowhee Mountains and every summer would come here and gradually finish it off for their retirement home. Not much has changed. You still see more Florida license plates than any others in this neck of the woods.

The place I'm renting now is 1400sf with three bedrooms and a very large great room. Perfect for a vacation space in the mountains. So, I'm using this as a model for my comments. If over the next 10 years we have selling price adjustments equal to what we have had over the past 10 years, your rental income should not only be paying for all of the mortgage and expenses but it will probably give you some additional money to invest.

Aside from the second home idea, VRBO.com is a "Vacation Rentals by Owners" website that people use to rent out their homes and, thus, help in paying off the place. Typically, these places rent for about \$200-\$400 a day during peak seasons, so through the summer, they could easily turn at least \$18,000. Then, the fall for 2 weeks can add another \$4,200 at minimum. Plus, there are several weeks in the winter when people like to come here to visit. If you allow for 20% expenses, that still gives you \$17,800 toward the mortgage. Home prices go into the millions here but most of the VRBO's would sell in the \$300K-\$500K range for 1500sf.

It's a given that Real Estate always exceeds the CPI (Consumer Price Index); you now have an investment


