At our October meeting, Trustee Suzy Giunta presented information on another new event to be held at Original Carrollwood Park on November 1 called "Woofstock." If you delayed reading this newsletter, by now Woofstock will have already occurred, but I'm sure it will prove to be a well-received event destined for a permanent place on the social calender of Carrollwood.

We can finally check another item off our "to do" list of goals. On Friday, September 30, our new loan finally closed. The substantial reduction in the interest rate resulted in a reduction of \$3,988 in our monthly debt payments. Treasurer Cary Brown started the project almost immediately after our Board took office in 2013; and after 18 long months of efforts the payoff has finally arrived. Our only regret is that we could not get it completed faster. Every month that has gone by during this record long, low interest rate economy was another savings opportunity lost.

Due to the savings, about \$100,000 that was held in reserves for future debt service is now immediately available for spending on improvements to our

- New irrigation pump at WSB
- New decorative fencing on the street side of Scotty Cooper Park
- Refinish parking lot at SCP
- New landscaping at SCP Upgrade walkway and fencing on strip of land immediately east of Bank of America
- New landscaping on Lake Carroll Way island at the Dale Mabry entrance
- Duck Island xeriscaping

This wish list likely adds up to over \$200,000; so needless to say, we have to set some priorities. Our priorities will be set based on whether a project is needed to improve safety and security, usage of the facilities, and resident input. If you are strongly for or against any one of these ideas, please attend one of our meetings in the very near future to express your opinion.

We did receive some resident input about the conditions of the fencing at OCP and the dog park. Much of the fencing has been damaged over the years by vandalism and other abuse. A good bit of the fencing is residential grade and is not (Continued on Page 6)



suitable for long-term use at a recreational facility. To redo all of the fencing with the appropriate grade would cost around \$100,000. The consensus at our October meeting was that we could not justify spending all of our capital improvement funds on this one project, so for the foreseeable future, we will continue to repair the fence until more funds are available.







# Mallards on Lipsey

For many years a Mallard duck would nest in my planter, which is attached to my pool. When her ducklings arrived, she would jump into the pool and encourage her new arrivals to do the same. The first year she came, I named her Mallory. I was quite concerned since the little ducklings did not have the strength to get out of the pool. I quickly built Mallory and family a little house made out of a pool float and the top of a dog house.

Mallory and her ducklings would eat bugs and whatever other critter made its way into my pool. Each year when I would find her nesting in my planter, I slowly decreased the chemicals in my pool so there would be ample food to eat. Although the male Mallard typically abandons the family after the female lays her eggs, Mallory and her brood received a daily visit from her beau, called a Drake, who hung out in my next door neighbor's yard.

By day they would eat, swim and take rides on my pool cleaner. By night she would gather them up and they would sleep under her while she slept with one eye open. Mallards have a special ability when it comes to sleeping. One half of their brain can sleep while the other half remains awake. When a mallard sleeps with one eye open, the half of its brain in the opposite side of its head is awake.







#### When the ducklings,

which can't fly for a few months, were strong enough to jump up out of the pool, Mallory would lead them to the wetlands of Lake Lipsey. While wondering if Mallory would be back next year, I would shock and cleanup my pool. Until I had to empty my planter for a repair, Mallory

came back year after year, which is actually quite common with female Mallards.

So add up your blessings, I say; Make Thanksgiving last more than a day. Enjoy what you've got; Realize it's a lot, And you'll make all your cares go away.





### OC REAL ESTATE SELLING YOUR HOME 101 Buyer's Closing Costs

Last month we discussed Seller's Closing Costs. This month we are discussing Buyer's Closing Costs. We will not discuss the many charges



that you would face for obtaining a mortgage, as they vary widely depending upon the firm being used.

The Seller pays the primary premium for title insurance, which protects you against any undiscovered clouds that may be on the property. However, the lender will require the Buyer to furnish a copy of the title insurance and its' endorsements. When incorporated into the title company fees this cost could be as much as half of the Seller's cost. Then there are stamps on the deed (\$.35/\$100) and intangible taxes on the mortgage (\$.20/\$100). There are government recording charges as well and storage fees plus title company recording fees.

You will most likely want to perform some inspections. For a 2,500 square foot home, you will spend about \$400 for a general inspection and an additional \$100 for a roof certification required by many insurance companies now, and \$100 for a pest inspection. Then a survey will be needed. If the Seller has a survey 20 years old or less, the title company will sometimes accept those. And last but not least, your realtor's broker will add in a processing fee which can be as high as \$500. You will benefit from prorates, such as taxes when the Seller has to pay you for whatever portion of the year they have lived in the home. That's an artificial credit to you since you have to give that back to the tax collector at the end of the year.

If you have an escrow with your mortgage, you will have

to advance the mortgage company three months worth of taxes and 15 months worth of Homeowners Insurance.

Adding all this up, on the purchase of a \$300K home with 20% down, you could possibly have closing costs in the range of \$6,000, plus down payment of \$60,000. Obviously, these numbers can vary, but it's sometimes helpful to understand where these costs are coming from.


