

As of September 28, 2015, the CFPB requirements, which resulted from the Dodd-Frank legislation that came after the 2008 crash, have been enacted which affect buyers and sellers

especially from a timing standpoint. Closing contracts in 30 days, which was previously not uncommon, will now take at least 45 days unless it is a cash transaction. If contract modifications are made, or if the HUD statement requires correction, these closings may be extended proportionately.

Previously, Title Evidence and Insurance Commitments were to be issued 5 days prior to the closing date. This has been moved up to 15 days prior, unless the buyer is paying cash and then the time span is 5 days. Surveys previously were required 5 days prior to closing. Now they must be completed prior to the Title Evidence Deadline as shown above. So be prepared for the additional time when you plan on buyer or selling a home.

Here are a couple of interesting statistics relative to today's housing market. Since 2010, when home foreclosures reached their peak, they have now fallen 66% - from 117,225 to 38,000 nationwide. The foreclosure inventory is about 1.2 % of all homes with mortgages since December of 2007. Short Sales are now almost non-existent, and there is a definite housing shortage, which has been exacerbated by slower new home construction and small bank's inability to make loans to homebuilders.

As you can see in my Original Carrollwood home sales this month, we only have 4 homes listed in MLS which equates to approximately ½ % of the communities homes. The normal number for balanced purchasing by buyers and sellers is 4%. Needless to say, this is unhealthy for everyone.



Spotlight on OC Resident: Timothy Freriks

Tim and his wife, Kathy, moved to Original Carrollwood (OC) almost 30 years ago (1987) with their baby daughter, Tyler. After months of research, he discovered OC and proclaims "I chose well. I love it here."

He didn't always live in Florida, he came to the state in 1980 from Cleveland, Ohio, to continue his career in commercial real estate. That was before he started his software companies. Now, Tim is "retired" and is a fultime author.

Tim is a forty-year veteran of entrepreneurial pursuits, starting and exiting six companies. He has been writing since his childhood, but started doing it seriously when he retired in 2012. "People seem to enjoy it, so I'll keep doing it until they tell me to stop," Tim explained.

When I asked Tim what inspires him to write, he replied, "I tend to be bored easily. Seriously, I love to create and live in more interesting environments than 'reality', which is way overrated, by the way. I like stories where I have control. In progress includes *Roland* - a historical piece about a boy in the late 18th Century America, and *Julia* - a chickit story about a strong, but odd, young woman who fights her way to the top of the fashion world. Tim added, "Why I'm writing that, I have no idea, but it's fun."

at about 6:30 p.m. "Book signing requests are always fulfilled for free at the Dog Park." he says.

Tim describes Original Carrollwood as never getting old or changing, and he finds that comforting. It helped give their daughter a sense of community and a strong foundation.

Tim's wife is the lead teacher for the acclaimed STEM Magnet Program at Middleton High School. His daughter, Tyler, went to Carrollwood Elementary and Chamberlain and, although she recently moved to Nashville, her roots remains in Original Carrollwood. The whole family shares Tim's sentiment about the neighborhood and are very proud to call it home.
