This being an election year, the month of June was the time to file and qualify to serve on the CRD Board. This process is done with the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections office in downtown Tampa. As with other communities throughout Hillsborough County, each person filing was required to pay a \$25 fee (or collect the signatures of 25 registered CRD voters), in addition to filing financial disclosures annually with the Florida Commission on Ethics while serving on the Board.

There are nine seats on the CRD Board, and as indicated to the right (snapshot from the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections website), nine OC residents have qualified. So, these nine "qualified electors" - OC residents - will automatically become elected at the November general election. If MORE than nine residents had filed, that would have triggered a contested election and ALL the names would have appeared on the November general election ballot. But since that did not happen, these nine residents are considered "unopposed", and thus will begin a 2-year board term in January.

This process of filing with the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections office has existed since the State Legislature created the CRD back in the early 1970's.

Grace Lutheran Church At Carrollwood Food Drive

Grace Lutheran Church at Carrollwood held a successful food drive at the Publix in Original Carrollwood in October. Residents of the Carrollwood Community were very generous and donated enough food for 18,431 servings. The Church was overwhelmed at the generosity. Besides the servings of food donated, baby food and cereal, condiments, pet food, powdered milk, cookies, syrup and 104 boxes of Ritz crackers were also donated.

The Church's Homeless in the Community sorted the food and donations were made to the Veterans Center, Kaye Prox Food Bank at the Lutheran Church of Our Savior, Morningside Church, which hands out bags of groceries twice a week to people whose pay checks run out before they get their next one, First Nesters that are young people who age out of foster care and are setting up an apartment before they start their new jobs or college and Grace members stock their cupboards when they move in, Forest Hills Elementary School where bags of groceries are sent home on Fridays with children who would otherwise not have food to eat over the weekend, McCulloch Group Home which cares for mentally challenged adults and Fisher House where families can stay free of charge when their loved one is in the Veterans Hospital for long recovery.

OC REAL ESTATE REAL ESTATE – 101 INTERNET AND REAL ESTATE

In the 80's my Engineering Manager put an XT generation computer on my desk. To say the



least, it was new to me, and I was not pleased, so I ignored it for a few days but then he convinced me that my Administrative Assistant was obsolete. I could finger type, but my spelling has always been somewhat questionable. Thank heavens for spellchecker.

With today's small smartphones we can do significantly more than an entire building filled with computer racks in the 80's. Real Estate has not been left out. We can search for homes and isolate those searches to almost any condition and location we want. This makes house hunting fun, and it also allows you to participate and help your Realtor in finding the right selling price or the right place for you.

The operative words here are "help your Realtor." One of the biggest challenges a Realtor has in working with his/her client is to eliminate what their client doesn't want. There are now over 50 major websites dedicated to Real Estate. They all have a little different spin on how they present properties. The main thing, however, is that they all get most of there information from Public Records and the MLS (Multiple Listing Service).

Where we see the danger often is in how unknown values are calculated. My biggest concern is their estimates of home values. Their formulas vary in many cases, and they can present false presentations. I used an example of a home on Lake Carroll with which I'm very familiar and found the estimate on one of these websites to be \$670.5K. But when using a true comparative

analysis this home would retail for more than \$800K. In another circumstance, I found a home classified as being in foreclosure, but it turned out the house in foreclosure was 2 doors away.

In reality, these websites are very helpful to buyers, sellers, and Realtors but they must be used with caution and the understanding that there are often irregularities that need to be sorted out. This is where your Realtor should be able to assist you. Good luck with your journey.


