



REAL ESTATE 101: HOMEBUYERS REGRET RECENT PURCHASES

Wy good friend and Realtor, KT Tershowski, passed a recent article to me that I found interesting but not surprising so I'm going to summarize these findings for you. Hopefully it doesn't reflect your views, but it can have an impact on future sales.

In a recent survey, it was recorded that 72% of the recent 2021-2022 homebuyers have regrets about their purchase. The number one reason for their remorse is they feel they spent too much money. Thirty-one percent of buyer's complaints surround the fact that they paid an average of \$65,000 over the asking price.

The second biggest complaint was that they believe they were too rushed, while an additional 30% believed that they acted too hastily. This was probably the result of 80% of the buyers having made more than one offer and 41% having made more than five offers.

Many people gave up requirements, such as home inspections, in order to get an advantage over other prospects. The end result was that many have suffered bills for big ticket items that failed after the property closed.

All of this leads to important things you need to do in this changing market. 1: You should insist on a home inspection even if you and the seller agree that the seller does not have to make the repairs. You need to know what you are getting into for future costs. 2: Get a realtor who has your back. Not only from the buy side but from the sell side as well. I come across numerous homes for sale and the realtors are located 15 or more miles away from the client and were chosen because they were family or a friend of a good friend, etc., etc. Just know if that agent isn't close by, they probably don't know your neighborhood as well and other

than entering your listing in MLS they are probably not going to have your back.

The market has changed! This is no longer a sellers' market with interest rates climbing at a rapid pace. You can't afford to be careless with the handling of your biggest investment.






