



he CRD Board would like to thank everyone for their efforts to help our Community following hurricane Milton. Our area faced a great deal of wind damage and some localized flooding. When the sun rose after the storm, it was amazing to see our Community come together to help each other and get our neighborhood back to its normal routines as much as possible. Neighbors cleared debris from storm drains to expedite draining, removed tree limbs from roadways, and helped each other manage despite the lack of electricity. The CRD properties each experienced impacts from the storm. White Sands Beach experienced flooding with water up over the docks and into the parking lots. Scotty Cooper Park had trees down blocking the playground. The Tennis Courts lost a fence and Original Carrollwood Park lost the baseball field lights. Getting the playground back in shape was important for the youngest in our Community and we would like to thank the Goan family and David Cura from Cura Sod Company for cleaning up debris the day after the storm. The clean-up at Scotty Cooper Park started with the Goan's and a small crew from Cura Sod and ended with Cura Sod sending over additional crews with chain saws and blowers. By the afternoon, all of the debris in the park had been removed and everything raked up, blown off, and ready for the kids to play. This response was sincerely appreciated! Another thank-you goes to both ASI Landscape Management

and Omega Tree & Nursery companies. Both companies responded quickly to our Community, making our clean-up needs a priority. They quickly removed fallen trees, and cleaned up areas at each of our facilities making them accessible for use very quickly after the storm. Finally, we thank our County Commissioner, Ken Hagan. He helped us connect with agencies and assisted in getting the large trees blocking roadways removed



in a timely manner. We truly appreciate all of the efforts as we continue to repair our facilities and return our Community amenities to their glory.

An OC Tradition

In the mid 1960s, Grace Allen (the wife of the first president of the University of South Florida and Original Carrollwood resident) had read about a southwestern Christmas Eve tradition of lighting candles placed in sand-filled paper bags called luminarias. She made a sample and suggested to the Carrollwood Civic Association that all the homes in Original Carrollwood light rows of candles in front of their property for a few hours on Christmas Eve. The idea was approved. Around 7 p.m. that Christmas eve, nearly every home in Original Carrollwood began to glow as neighbors strolled along the sidewalks. shared holiday cheer, and enjoyed a relaxing evening. The tradition has continued ever since! Original Carrollwood's luminarias have gained popularity throughout Tampa as many residents of other neighborhoods drive through each year to enjoy them.

Every year in Original Carrollwood we line our yards and common areas with luminaria on Christmas Eve inspiring good will and spreading the joy of the season. Please join us in this long-standing neighborhood tradition.

If you have a corner or double lot, we suggest buying two kits. If you're going to be out of town, out for the evening, or unable to set up your luminaria, the scouts will set up your luminaria on Christmas Eve morning for a small donation. See price list.

This year, we are offering the option to pre-purchase Luminaria Kits ONLINE for Original Carrollwood residents. Choose between 1 to 3 kits, which will be delivered to your address by the scout troop.

Community Service Is Part of the Mission

The Boy Scouts of Troop 217 are honored to support the luminaria tradition of Original Carrollwood. Last year, the Scouts donated hundreds of hours folding more than 16,000 luminary bags, setting up and cleaning up 4,000 luminaries in the common areas, and ensuring that the luminary kits were assembled, delivered and cleaned up as necessary. After Christmas, the Scouts took the used luminaries, sifted the sand to clean them of debris, and returned the cleaned sand to White Sands Beach. As a thanks for their hard work, the Carrollwood Civic Association made a generous donation to Troop 217 to help pay for summer camp and countless good deeds.
